

Through our efficient use of donations, we contribute >87% of revenue to programs.

To ensure our adaptability to the cancer community's evolving needs, especially around health equity, digital literacy, and clinical trial awareness, we are seeking to increase unrestricted giving to at least 10% of our annual operating budget by 2025.

What differentiates Patient Empowerment Network from other cancer advocacy groups is that we take patient education a step further.

We educate, then activate patients and their care partners to become co-decision makers with their healthcare teams.

Cancer patients and their loved ones in underrepresented communities who are at any stage of disease.

DESCRIPTION:

This program aims to provide digital literacy skills training to older cancer patients and underrepresented communities across the U.S. by building the capacity of community-based organizations (CBOs) to deliver educational workshops through a 'Train-the-Trainer' initiative of our established digital sherpa™ program. To date, this program has empowered more than 7,000 older individuals across America and has provided a \$2500 start-up grant to each CBO to administer the program.

DELIVERABLES:

- This initiative catalyzes a multiplier effect that will create upstream solutions to the inequities faced by cancer patients and caregivers who are not yet digitally empowered, while building the capacity of locally-focused nonprofits to serve the cancer patients in their communities.
- In 2023, at least 10 nonprofit delivery partners will be trained to lead digital sherpa™ workshops for the cancer patients and care partners in their communities.

OUTCOMES:

Patients and their loved ones will feel more equipped to navigate online resources to improve their cancer outcomes.


