Advice for Accessing Personalized Care

- Consider seeking care with a gynecological cancer specialist who has experience treating endometrial cancer.
- Ask your doctor about the type and stage of your endometrial cancer to help guide your care decisions.
- Make sure you have undergone all essential testing, including biomarker testing, and ask how the results may affect your prognosis and treatment options.
- Review and understand all of the therapies available to you, including clinical trials.
- Before making a treatment decision, discuss the pros and cons of each option with your doctor and a care partner, such as a family member or friend.
- Remember, you are at the center of care decisions, don't hesitate to voice your concerns and to ask questions.

Glossary

Biomarker: Measurable substances found in the blood, urine, or tissues of some people with cancer. Biomarkers may also refer to mutations, changes, or patterns in a tumor's DNA.

CA-125 (Cancer antigen 125) Test: Looks for high levels of CA-125, which could be a sign of endometrial cancer.

Immunotherapy: Type of therapy that harnesses one's own immune system to help the body fight cancer, infection, and other diseases.

Lynch syndrome: An inherited condition that is linked to an increased risk of developing cancer.

PARP inhibitors are a type of targeted therapy that target poly (ADP-ribose) polymerase, a protein in cells.
